Rejoice with the angels at this good news.



What We Need is Here (excerpt) Wendell Berry

Geese appear high over us, pass, and the sky closes. Abandon, as in love or sleep, holds Them to their way, clear
In the ancient faith: what we need
Is here. And we pray, not
For a new earth or heaven, but to be

Quiet in heart, and in eye,
clear. What we need is here.

I believe in God the Father, the Almighty God above, Maker of the earth and heaven which were formed in God's great love. And in Jesus, loving Jesus, God's own Son, who makes us new. This, the creed of generations, is the faith for our church, too.
