SCRIPTURE READINGS

2 Corinthians 5:1-21 For we know that if the earthly tent we live in is destroyed,
we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens.

2 For in this tent we groan, longing to be clothed with our heavenly dwelling-- 3 if
indeed, when we have taken it off we will not be found naked. 4 For while we are
still in this tent, we groan under our burden, because we wish not to be unclothed
but to be further clothed, so that what is mortal may be swallowed up by life.

5 He who has prepared us for this very thing is God, who has given us the
Spirit as a guarantee. 6 So we are always confident; even though we know that
while we are at home in the body we are away from the Lord-- 7 for we walk by
faith, not by sight. 8 Yes, we do have confidence, and we would rather be away
from the body and at home with the Lord. 9 So whether we are at home or away,
we make it our aim to please him. 10 For all of us must appear before the judgment
seat of Christ, so that each may receive recompense for what has been done in the
body, whether good or evil.

11 Therefore, knowing the fear of the Lord, we try to persuade others; but we
ourselves are well known to God, and I hope that we are also well known to your
consciences. 12 We are not commending ourselves to you again, but giving you an
opportunity to boast about us, so that you may be able to answer those who boast in
outward appearance and not in the heart. 13 For if we are beside ourselves, it is for
God; if we are in our right mind, it is for you. 14 For the love of Christ urges us on,
because we are convinced that one has died for all; therefore all have died. 15 And
he died for all, so that those who live might live no longer for themselves, but for
him who died and was raised for them.

16 From now on, therefore, we regard no one from a human point of view;
even though we once knew Christ from a human point of view, we know him no
longer in that way. 17 So if anyone is in Christ, there is a new creation: everything

old has passed away; see, everything has become new! 18 All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ, and has given us the ministry of reconciliation; 19 that is, in Christ God was reconciling the world to himself, not counting their trespasses against them, and entrusting the message of reconciliation to us. 20 So we are ambassadors for Christ, since God is making his appeal through us; we entreat you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. 21 For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

Mark 8:22-26 They came to Bethsaida. Some people brought a blind man to him and begged him to touch him. He took the blind man by the hand and led him out of the village; and when he had put saliva on his eyes and laid his hands on him, he asked him, "Can you see anything?" And the man looked up and said, "I can see people, but they look like trees, walking." Then Jesus laid his hands on his eyes again; and he looked intently and his sight was restored, and he saw everything clearly. Then he sent him away to his home, saying, "Do not even go into the village."

Holy, mighty, and merciful Lord,

In the night in which he was betrayed,
